The Doctrine of the Final Judgment

- 1) Satisfies our inward sense of a need for justice in the world
- 2) Enables us to forgive others freely
- 3) Provides a motive for righteous living
- 4) Compels us to evangelize

From the Gospel of Matthew

- 1. The punishment of hell consists of conscious suffering.
- 2. Hell is the ultimate destruction.
- 3. Hell is the ultimate banishment.
- 4. Hell is eternal.
- 5. Hell is to be avoided at all cost.

ROMANS

- 1. Those who are without Christ are under God's wrath and can only be spared by being justified in Christ.
- 2. This future punishment will consist of "trouble and distress."
- 3. This future punishment is also portrayed as banishment from God's kingdom.
- 4. The intensity of the punishment will be in proportion to one's sinful behavior.

2 THESSALONIANS 1:5-10

- 1. God is just; sinners will face his retributive justice.
- 2. Hell is punishment and condemnation for those who do not obey the gospel.
- 3. Hell is eternal destruction.
- 4. Hell is exclusion and banishment from God's presence and majesty.
